

# THIRD ANNUAL NATIONAL INTERCOLLEGIATE JUDO CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Third Annual National Intercollegiate Judo Championship Tournament was held at Texas Western College at El Paso, Texas, on April 18 under the direction of Mr. Frank Fullerton of the host Texas Western College Judo Club.

The team from San Jose State dominated the tournament, scoring 54 points to win first place

for the third consecutive year and taking four first places and two seconds in six events. Coach of the San Jose State team is Yosh Uchida (sixth Dan), Chairman of the U.S. Olympic Judo Committee and manager-coach of the 1964 U.S. Olympic Judo team.

Other team results were: second, Air Force Academy (22 points), third, Colorado State University (16 points), and fourth, Texas Western (13 points).

The overall individual title went to San Jose's Makoto Ohbayashi, now the AAU and National Collegiate Judo Association national champion. Other individual results were:
